

## **NRG: Mac & FileMaker Shipping Software**

### **How can I print shipping labels to an alternate thermal printer when using FileMaker Pro?**

UPS for FileMaker preferences allow selection of a single output device, which requires all workstations to be setup consistently in a multi-user environment. However, when integrated with FileMaker Pro you can override the default settings by setting a value in one of the following global fields in the ship table:

Network Output

Output\_IPNumber - IP number of remote printers

Output\_Username - Username assigned on remote printer

Output\_Password - Password assigned on remote printer

Windows Output

Output\_WindowsPort - Port name that should be used for output

Mac Output

No adjustment is required for Mac users that have USB connected printers.

Note that because these fields are global, they can be set on a workstation by workstation basis in your database.
